PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

We have two teaching placements currently running in Sri Lanka, and each one is very unique! For further details on the rural teaching placement, please click here: [Teaching in Wasgamuwa](#). Remember that you are able to combine teaching in different places even doing 1 month at each placement if you wish. The programs are quite flexible so we will try and accommodate your timetable and your preferences. Each teaching project that we run offers a true flavour of the diverse island of Sri Lanka!

WORK CONTENT

Volunteers currently teach English at four of the poorest schools in the area. Volunteers can also teach at a charity centre that was set-up to provide computer training for school leavers/adults. As such, the teaching is very varied and volunteers usually teach a wide range of pupils and ages. Some volunteers develop a particular liking for one of the teaching environments and wherever possible we try to enable volunteers to concentrate on their favourite school.

Ages at the four schools range from between 5 to 18 years and you will teach spoken English for about two hours each morning from Monday to Friday. The schools aren't the most organised which means that you will need to have a very flexible approach to lesson planning. Generally, you will rotate around the different schools on a rota basis and teach the class given to you each morning by the school's principle. Because of this it's best to plan your lessons on a one-off basis, much as a supply teacher would do, as it's unlikely you will get the continuation of teaching a particular class time and time again. There is also great variation in the abilities of the students within any given class so you will need to aim your lessons mid range with perhaps additional learning for the faster kids.

The children range from shy and polite to energetic bordering on boisterous, depending on which school and which age group they are from – however all of the pupils are keen to learn English as it is essential if they are to be able to secure good jobs later in their lives. Good spoken English is a prerequisite of many careers in Sri Lanka.

You will also have the opportunity to teach English to school leavers at CECO. CECO is the 'Children's Education and Charity Organisation' and aims to educate school leavers in Computer Skills in order to improve their job prospects. Travellers' volunteers are invaluable in providing the basic English skills needed for this purpose.

REMEMBER...

Each school and its students will be different from the next. You will find a great mix of students within your placement but you will need to adjust your preparation and teaching accordingly. What the students all seem to have in common however is an intrigue and fascination with the western volunteers. They are very keen to impress you and to interact with you and the service that this volunteering program continues to bring to these schools is literally immeasurable.

Travellers and YOU provide extra classrooms, school uniforms, text books, computers, playgrounds and more for these schools and your dedication to teaching enables many students the opportunity to get decent jobs and escape a life of struggle and poverty. Although these children have not had a fortunate start in life in terms of riches, these children are brimming with joy, enthusiasm and a cheekiness that you will become very fond of!

WHAT KIND OF PERSON WOULD THIS PROJECT SUIT?

Someone who would like to help the people of Sri Lanka whilst having lots of free time to explore this beautiful island and socialise with the other volunteers! You must be good at going with the flow, expecting the unexpected (such as a cow strolling into your classroom!), love being around children and be able to get on with all different kinds of people!

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

Don't worry about not having special qualifications. The whole idea of Travellers is to provide any help possible, whether it is merely enabling children to hear English pronunciation by native English speakers, or any additional help with academic subjects or how to use a computer - anything you can offer is very much appreciated and everyone knows you are not a qualified teacher. The emphasis is on much-needed language development, additional learning and cultural contact. Everybody involved knows that Travellers teachers do not have to have TEFL or teaching qualifications. However, if you have a TEFL qualification or any other degree or diploma, then please take your certificate or a good photocopy thereof with you, or a statement from your university saying that you are a graduate.

LOCATION

Our longest running teaching project in Sri Lanka is situated just north of Colombo, Sri Lanka's bustling and chaotic Capital city. Ja-Ela (shown right) is 1 hour from Colombo and equal distance from Negombo, the popular tourist beach resort. Teaching, Work Experience and the Colombo Zoo placements are all based in Ja-Ela and so the house is often full and offers a lively, sociable atmosphere – there will be no shortage of friends to spend weekends at the beach with! Ja-Ela volunteers also have the advantage of easy access to Colombo's facilities, major bus stations and also The Airport Gardens Hotel - a luxury hotel which offers facilities including a fantastic pool. The hotel is only a short trip away from the volunteer house: perfect for those lazy afternoons!

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

We are unfortunately not able to offer teaching programmes during the school holidays. Holidays in Sri Lanka are usually as follows:

- The month of April
- The month of August
- 15th December – 5th January

However, you are more than welcome to spend a holiday period travelling independently, or taking part in one of our Conservation Projects and then return to teaching at the beginning of the new term! Please speak to your Project Co-ordinator about how we can tailor your placement to suit you!

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD

Travellers' has a traditional Sri Lankan house in Ja-Ela. It is spacious and comfortable, with a garden, several balconies, two lounge rooms and many bedrooms. You will most likely share a room with other Travellers volunteers. There is a TV and DVD player for evening entertainment, in the upstairs lounge area and with the latest DVD copies just a pound to buy locally, there is usually something to watch!

There is a local live-in chef at the Travellers house who will prepare your breakfast, lunch and dinner each day, throughout the week. We also have other staff at the house 24 hours a day for cleaning, assistance, security and comfort!



The food is usually local cuisine which means lots of curry, rice and salads. Whether a curry fan or not, you will be by the time you return as Sri Lankan food is delicious! You can buy snacks and treats, including a growing variety of Western tastes (chocolate!) from the local store. There is also a KFC in Ja-Ela for those who need a fix of home!

The area of Ja-Ela is an industrialised town and although it is not one of the paradise beauty spots, it's a good point at which to start your exploration of the island's many beaches and beautiful inland resorts.

Most schools are between two and five kilometres from the house and you will be taken to and from the schools every day. We hope that you will relax and feel comfortable in your accommodation but we do ask you to respect the property as you would your own home.

INDUCTION ON ARRIVAL

When you arrive in Sri Lanka, you'll be met from the airport by our delightful Managers, Roshan or Nirangela and their big welcoming smiles. They will take you to Ja-Ela (just down the road from the airport) where you will be introduced to the other volunteers on the placement and to our lovely staff at your new home.

Everyone is always extremely friendly and very excited to see a new face. You will be looked after immediately and taken under the collective wing soon to be absorbed in stories of wonderful weekend trips and the all important Sinhalese vocabulary such as harihundi (very good!). You will be made to feel very welcome and at home and then you will most likely need a little sleep before a hearty meal and exploring your new surroundings or starting on your tan!

There is plenty of support at the house - 24 hours a day with live in staff that will happily help you to understand and get around this new and exotic culture. Plus, you have the support and friendship of the other volunteers which makes adjusting very easy and fast – a little homesickness is normal for a few days however, trust us, it won't last longer than your first day in the school!

VISA

Visas are required for most nationalities visiting Sri Lanka. We will liaise with you about your visa requirements – the process is very straightforward.

FLIGHTS

You have the option to arrange your own flights or we can assist you with your flight arrangements. If you would like us to do this for you, we will liaise with you regarding available flights and dates to suit you.
