Children in Sri Lanka are a joy to teach, their enthusiasm for sports really knows no bounds. Although for the vast majority, coaching won't have a direct impact on their lives as they are unlikely to become the next David Beckham, indirectly it has immeasurable effects. Personality changes, health awareness, increased confidence and social skills are all benefits from the coaching they might otherwise fail to receive. There is massive scope for your input on this project: you can set up clubs, create tournaments or even bring other sports into the mix if you have a particular passion for one.

WORK CONTENT

You will get the opportunity to coach football at a range of local schools in a very unique placement! Depending on what's needed at the time, you may spend most of your time at one particular school, or at a combination of schools. Please ask us if you have a particular preference. The schools we work at generally have about 400 to 500 pupils aged 5 to 16 years old. The facilities are basic but the children are excited about playing football and being coached by our volunteers. The pitches in Sri Lanka are typically gravel and dirt pitches, which makes the game of football very quick and exciting as it is played at a very different pace and style to European football.

Sports lessons/practices are often either before the school day begins or after it's finished. You may also be able to hold some sports lessons/practices during the school day, this is especially true during the January – March term. During this term a special emphasis is given to sports– and towards the end of the term all the schools hold a sports day – for some of the schools this can be a very big occasion!

In the past, volunteers have worked alongside the teachers to create and coach school teams to play in the inter-schools Travellers Football Tournaments, which they organised as part of their programme. The tournaments were established to provide the children with the opportunity to play football competitively, which many of the children haven't had, so towards the end of your placement, you may be able to organise a tournament that brings together all the schools you've been working with to play against each other. In the past, volunteers have organised very successful football tournaments which have been the highlight of the year for the children at the school given the honour to represent their school.

During your programme you may also get the opportunity to coach at a local football club – The 'Katunayake All-Stars'. It should be noted that coaching at Katunayake may involve working early evenings or some weekends. Coaching the club is extremely fun and rewarding! It gives you a real chance to get to know the locals and become part of the team!

A TYPICAL DAY

You will usually coach from 7 – 8:30 am Monday to Friday and then again after school has finished, so your hours will be slightly different to those of the teaching volunteers. The only available coaching takes place before and after school hours, so you are more than welcome to teach English with the other volunteers to fill up your hours if you wish!

LOCATION

Our football coaching project is situated just north of Colombo, Sri Lanka's bustling and chaotic Capital city. Ja-Ela is 1 hour from Colombo and equal distance from Negombo, the popular tourist beach resort. Teaching, Work Experience and the Colombo Zoo placements are also based in Ja-Ela and so the house is often full and offers a lively, sociable atmosphere – there will be no shortage of friends to spend weekends at the beach with! Ja-Ela volunteers also have

the advantage of easy access to Colombo's facilities, major bus stations and also The Airport Gardens Hotel - a luxury hotel which offers facilities including a fantastic pool. The hotel is only a short trip away from the volunteer house: perfect for those lazy afternoons!

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

We are unfortunately not able to offer coaching programmes during the school holidays. Holidays in Sri Lanka are usually as follows:

- The month of April
- The month of August
- 15th December – 5th January

However, you are more than welcome to spend a holiday period travelling independently, or taking part in one of our Conservation Projects and then return to teaching at the beginning of the new term! Please speak to your Project Co-ordinator about how we can tailor your placement to suit you!

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD

Travellers' has a traditional Sri Lankan house in Ja-Ela. It is spacious and comfortable, with a garden, several balconies, two lounge rooms and many bedrooms. You will most likely share a room with other Travellers volunteers. There is a TV and DVD player for evening entertainment, in the upstairs lounge area and with the latest DVD copies just a pound to buy locally, there is usually something to watch!



There is a local live-in chef at the Travellers house who will prepare your breakfast, lunch and dinner each day, throughout the week. We also have other staff at the house 24 hours a day for cleaning, assistance, security and comfort!

The food is usually local cuisine which means lots of curry, rice and salads. Whether a curry fan or not, you will be by the time you return as Sri Lankan food is delicious! You can buy snacks and treats, including a growing variety of Western tastes (chocolate!) from the local store. There is also a KFC in Ja-Ela for those who need a fix of home!

The area of Ja-Ela is an industrialised town and although it is not one of the paradise beauty spots, it's a good point at which to start your exploration of the island's many beaches and beautiful inland resorts.

Most schools are between two and five kilometres from the house and you will be taken to and from the schools every day. We hope that you will relax and feel comfortable in your accommodation but we do ask you to respect the property as you would your own home.

INDUCTION ON ARRIVAL

When you arrive in Sri Lanka, you'll be met from the airport by our delightful Managers, Roshan or Nirangela and their big welcoming smiles. They will take you to Ja-Ela (just down the road from the airport) where you will be introduced to the other volunteers on the placement and to our lovely staff at your new home.

Everyone is always extremely friendly and very excited to see a new face. You will be looked after immediately and taken under the collective wing soon to be absorbed in stories of wonderful weekend trips and the all important Sinhalese vocabulary such as harihundi (very good!). You will be made to feel very welcome and at home and then you will most likely need a little sleep before a hearty meal and exploring your new surroundings and starting on your tan!

There is plenty of support at the house - 24 hours a day with live in staff that will happily help you to understand and get around this new and exotic culture. Plus, you have the support and friendship of the other volunteers which makes adjusting very easy and fast – a little homesickness is normal for a few days however, trust us, it won't last longer than your first day in the school!
