## PROGRAMME OVERVIEW:

Teach disadvantaged children in township schools in a beautiful resort town. You'll work with underprivileged communities who really appreciate your help. You can choose to work with primary or secondary schools.

### The Teaching Programme

Our teaching programme is based in the beautiful Western Cape's Garden Route area, situated in Knysna. The schools cater for many children from the poorer township community. Your help and support are appreciated by everyone, but mostly by the children! Our programme has been running in this region for many years and the impact our volunteers have had is amazing. Many of them return again and again. The result is a community that has benefited tremendously since we started.

Standards in the schools are generally average, but materials and resources may be scarce. Even with the lack of facilities, etc., the enthusiasm of the students and staff at the schools more than make up for this. The children have a fantastic energy about them and you will be immediately welcomed in by hoards of children running up to greet the new teacher. It is often difficult to stop them smiling!

### Work Content

You'll normally begin your placement by assisting the teachers but, depending on your ability, you may progress very quickly on to being given complete control of a particular class or group. You'll receive a lot of help and support from the teachers and staff at the schools, but you should be prepared to use your own initiative and ask when you need something. The average class size is about 40.

### Teaching English

You will normally be asked to assist with teaching conversational English - you are not expected to be an expert on grammar or literature. The important thing is to help people speak English. You may also be asked to help with other subjects but this is optional and it is only if you feel confident.

We provide you with a teaching Suggestions Booklet which has ideas for teaching English and will also help structuring lessons in other subjects. Video facilities are available in some schools and audio equipment is quite commonplace.

Most of the schools are State schools, both secondary and primary. You will generally be asked to help out with any age groups. You are, in fact, very likely to be in popular demand everywhere - in and out of the classroom.

### Teaching Drama, Music & Dance

Drama, Music & Dance classes are called Arts & Culture class and run in conjunction with the Life Orientation classes. The purpose of these classes is to develop Team work, Confidence, Self Esteem, Communication Skills and Leadership.

People from all backgrounds can participate in drama, developing essential skills by learning to express themselves and gain self-confidence. Theatre can be aimed at young people, old people, disadvantaged people, sick people, homeless people - to educate and inform or simply to entertain. This can take the form of productions for schools, orphanages, old people's homes, plays for the education of local children, theatre workshops for disadvantaged children.

- Organising and putting on drama workshops in various township schools in Knysna. This would involve energising warm-ups, improvisations, dance-drama and devising pieces of theatre in small groups.
- Organising drama sessions during school-time for pupils.
- Helping the local school children to put on a small-scale productions so that they can all be involved in some aspect of it (either acting, creating costumes, masks, set or make-up). Please note that these may not always take place during your project - it will depend on what's happening when you're there and where in the school curriculum the classes are.
- Devising and performing educational pieces of theatre (on issues such as bullying) for the school children at any available venues (town hall/school yard/wherever!).
- Alongside the drama, volunteers could also help out with conversational English classes (and any other subjects where needed). It may also be possible to incorporate drama lessons into the English classes, perhaps once a week.



### Teaching Design Technology

Walk around the streets anywhere in Africa, but especially in the townships, and you'll be overwhelmed by the creative talent in the communities. From the Craftsmen who make cooking pots from discarded oil drums on the road side, to souvenirs. If you look at the shanty houses, you'll be impressed by the initiative used in putting them together.

Design Technology was introduced into the school curriculum in South Africa back in 2000. It has proven to be extremely popular amongst the children. The problem is that many of the poorer township schools know little about the subject and are in desperate need for people with design experience to come to their schools, bringing with them their own ideas and hopefully help to nurture a new generation of design thinkers in South Africa.

For this programme you will be placed at one of the high schools.

This is an excellent placement for anyone studying or has good knowledge of Design Technology. By helping the children have a greater knowledge of the subject, you will find that the teachers will be extremely grateful for the support and knowledge as this is a subject the schools are still learning about.



### Coaching Sports

As with Drama classes, sports classes also run in conjunction with the Life Orientation classes. The purpose of these classes is to develop Team work, Confidence, Self Esteem, Communication Skills and Leadership.

These classes also help to develop skills, knowledge, values and attitudes that empower learners to make informed decisions and take appropriate actions regarding:

- Health promotion
- Social development
- Personal development
- Physical development, movement and orientation to the world of work.



As sports lessons are run in conjunction with life orientation classes it is difficult to say how often you will be able to coach sports, therefore please note that you will not be guaranteed full time sports coaching on this particular project.

However if you use your own initiative to generate sports activity when and where you can or even after school, then we are sure that you will gain so much from this experience, just seeing those happy faces on those enthusiastic children will make it all so worthwhile!

The following sports are usually popular:

- Football (April to September)
- Cricket (October to April)
- Netball (Usually all year round)
- Rugby (February to September/October)

Although facilities are basic, there is still a lot that you can do.

Please ask your Project Coordinator if there is a subject that you would like to get involved with that is not listed above, as it may be likely that something can be arranged for you. Please note that the above subjects will not be full-time, so you will be asked to combine them with teaching English too, so that you have more of a full timetable.



### Working Hours & Term Times

School hours are generally from 8am until 2pm, however you are likely to be collected from your accommodation at about 7.30am to ensure that you are at school and settled in before the students arrive.

Quite often there are after-school activities that you can get involved with; such as helping out at a local soup kitchen. Further details on the current activities available will be given to you during your induction on arrival in South Africa.

Please note that teaching is only available during the school term times which are as follows:

### LOCATION:

The Garden Route area is famous throughout South Africa for its beauty and is a favourite resort for holidaymakers and weekenders. It is situated in the Western Cape Province and is very central, lying halfway between Cape Town and Port Elizabeth. The majestic Outeniqua Mountain lies to the north and the Indian Ocean to the South, giving the area a very moderate Mediterranean climate.

Knysna is a lovely holiday resort town, very popular among South Africans and international tourists alike. It is situated in between George and Plettenberg Bay, and is very famous for the beauty of its lagoon. The atmosphere is very relaxed and you will find plenty to do in and around Knysna.

### ACCOMMODATION & FOOD:

In Knysna, you will live in our volunteer house with other Travellers volunteers. You will most probably be sharing a room with other people. It will depend on how many people are there at the same time as you. The house is very comfortable and situated at walking distance from the town centre.

You will be provided with a food budget so that you can cook and prepare your own meals.

The Western Cape region includes Knysna, George and Plettenberg bay. These small towns lie on the world-famous Garden Route and are conveniently placed halfway between Cape Town and Port Elizabeth. Here we have very worthwhile teaching, care and sports projects as well as one or two work experience placements. This is a very social

environment where the majestic Outeniqua Mountain lies to the north and the Indian Ocean to the South, giving the town a very moderate Mediterranean climate.

KwaZulu-Natal (KZN) is home of some of the most stunning Game Reserves in the world. This is glorious country, exotic, tropical, at once arid and unbelievably lush. Here Travellers has exciting conservation projects on Game Parks, working with animals and plants, and also our monkey rehabilitation project. We have a superb rural teaching placement working with Zulu children and an equally excellent Care project. KZN is the place to be for the true African experience.

Port Elizabeth is given the title of the 'Friendly City' by locals; Port Elizabeth (or simply 'PE') is a major tourist attraction. Lying alongside Algoa Bay on the south eastern coast, PE has a stunning shoreline and longer hours of sunshine than anywhere else in South Africa. With water sports galore, PE is a beach lover's paradise!

The Cape Peninsula has a Mediterranean climate with well-defined seasons. Summer temperatures are mild, with an average maximum of about 26°C (79°F). Winter lasts from May to September. The months are cool, with an average minimum temperature of 7°C (45°F). Most of the city's annual rainfall occurs in wintertime, but due to the mountainous topography of the city, rainfall amounts for certain areas can vary dramatically. The Peninsula gets frequent strong South-Easterly winds, locally known as the 'Cape Doctor', because it blows away pollution and cleans the air!

- **Birds of Eden**, a bird sanctuary
- **Extreme sports** like sky diving, paragliding, kite surfing, sand boarding, surfing and mountain biking
- **The Cango Caves**, a truly awesome cave system and a must on your sightseeing list.
- **Whale and dolphin boat trips**
- **Zip line canopy through the Tsikamma forest**
- **Bloukrans Bridge**, the world's highest bungee jump at 216m
- **Internationally recognised Scuba diving courses**
- **Wildcat Experience** in Plettenberg Bay where you can walk cheetahs on a harness at sunset
- **Oudtshoorn**, home of the ostrich farms and crocodile cage diving
- **Victoria Bay and Herold's Bay**, renowned for surfing, bathing and fishing.
- **Four superb Golf Courses** and numerous other sports facilities, including flying, paragliding, squash, horse riding, tennis, hiking and mountain biking.
